# Director of Writing Center Job Posting

### **POSITION:**

Director of Writing Center

### **JOB SUMMARY:**

Spalding University invites applications for the Director of the University Writing Center (UWC). This position is a 12-month tenure-track position in the School of Liberal Studies, with a teaching load of 2 undergraduate courses of first-year writing.

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The Director is responsible for overseeing the day-to-day operations of the UWC; hiring, supervising, and mentoring graduate and undergraduate student writing consultants; coordinating the assessment of the UWC's effectiveness; providing ongoing vision for the UWC; working with students directly to strengthen writing and study skills; working with faculty to incorporate writing into their classrooms and to conduct workshops related to writing and the writing process; analyzing quantitative and qualitative data to report on Writing Center services in order to promote student success and retention; working with Spalding's SACSCOC QEP based on Writing Through Revision; and representing the UWC on departmental and university committees.

## **SKILLS AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Ph.D. in Rhetoric and Composition from a regionally accredited university, or closely related field.
- 2. Minimum two years of experience in writing center administration.
- 3. Candidates with training in writing center theory and administration;
- 4. A record of teaching excellence in college-level writing courses
- 5. A record of Writing Studies scholarship with applicability to writing center context will receive special consideration.

### **INTERRELATIONS:**

- Work directly with students across campus to foster a culture of writing dedicated to student success
- Evaluate and recommend writing technologies for campus and library needs
- Work with the QEP Director to collect, assess, and analyze data related to Writing Across the Curriculum
- Partner with campus faculty, staff, and students as a facilitator, workshop trainer, designer, and developer of writing materials
- Create university-wide connections with faculty teaching writing intensive courses.
