Students with previous graduate credit may transfer up to 30 hours of course-work into the program. All course transfers require faculty approval.

- 1. The Director of graduate Training must approve all transfer credit.
- 2. Transfer credit is given only for course work with a grade of B or higher at the graduate level from regionally accredited institutions.
- 3. Transfer credit is given only for courses that are equivalent in sophistication and content/skills to courses at Spalding University.
- 4. Transfer credit may not be awarded for an equivalent course if in the judgment of the evaluator the course was taken too long ago to be of current value.
- 5. Transfer credit may be denied if in the judgment of the evaluator the course would not be acceptable to state boards of psychology.
- 6. Ordinarily, credit is given for course work taken in psychology programs. However, credit may be given for work in closely related programs provided the above criteria are met.

The transfer of credits policy will not necessarily impact program length as it greatly depends on unique coursework and how that maps on to Spalding's degree requirements.
